

Belmont Park Racquets Club COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

As a condition of entry to the Club's premises (all areas of the Club's facilities including the Clubhouse, tennis and squash courts) from 1 December 2021 onwards all Members, Members' guests, Independent Contractors and other visitors aged 12 and over must:

- 1. have received both injections of a government-approved COVID-19 vaccination, and**
- 2. on request, agree to show or provide their My Vaccine Pass to a Club Committee member or the Club Manager for verification.**

A negative covid test is not an acceptable alternative to being vaccinated. All visitors must be able to produce their official My Vaccine Pass certificate.

An exemption to this Policy is available for any person who has a legitimate medical reason and obtains a Temporary Medical Exemption issued by a NZ Government-approved body. A copy of the exemption must be provided on entry to the club.

Given the evolving nature of COVID-19 and the Government's responses and policies towards managing the pandemic, the Committee will keep this Policy under review and will update it when and if required.

This Policy comes into effect on 1 December 2021.
